#### LEADS ADMINISTRATIVE RULES REVISED

The LEADS Administrative Rules have been revised and are online on the CJIS Launchpad/CJIS Manuals.

- Administrative Rule 13 has been rescinded.
- Administrative Rules 13A, 13B and 13C have new forms.

*New administrator*? Use the LEADS *Participation Agreement* for terminal OR non-terminal agencies.

*New vendor*? Use the LEADS *Agreement* to register new vendors.

These forms can be obtained on the CJIS Launchpad/CJIS Documents/LEADS Forms.

#### AUDIT IMPLEMENTATION

#### NON-TERMINAL AGENCY AND MDT-ONLY ACCESS AGENCY AUDITS

For the July 1, 2013 – June 30, 2016 audit cycle, LEADS is creating an audit program for non-terminal agencies that only access LEADS with mobile data terminals (MDTs).

Areas assessed will include, but are not limited to, training, printout audit trails, dissemination, security issues and when applicable, validation procedures and MDT locations. An auditor will contact agencies to schedule the audit. Non-terminal agencies and non-terminal agencies with MDTs should have an appointed representative, a Non-Terminal Agency Coordinator (NTAC), who is responsible for LEADS access and use. The NTAC must be present for the audit. It is recommended the agency administrator or designated representative be available for an exit interview at the audit's completion.

To ensure an agency is in compliance, review LEADS *Administrative Rules*, LEADS *Security Policy* and *Security Awareness Training* prior to the audit.

#### **LEADS Fee Structure**

#### **CONCEALED CARRY PERMIT**

The Concealed Carry Permit is now called Concealed Handgun License. The 129th General Assembly amended Substitute House Bill Number 495 and modified the language references to Concealed Handgun



License. LEADS has responded in kind and changed the language references as well.

#### **AGENCY SERVICE REQUEST FORM**

If your agency is going to become a Non-Terminal or Non-Entering agency:

• LEADS must be notified in writing 45 days in advance. Due to records having to be switched and other operational changes needed, written notification including the date of the change and the contact person's name and phone number or e-mail must be included.

When an agency becomes a Non-Entering agency:

• The Holder of Record forms must be completed with the agency making their entries.



#### OVI AUTOMATIC LICENSE SUSPENSION AS A BASE RECORD

All Automatic License Suspension (ALS) entries must be entered as a base record. This will avoid any problems resulting from the entry not being purged in a timely manner. The base record automatically purges after 15 days. If the ALS is entered as an Add-On Warrant, it will not automatically purge. At this point, the record must be manually removed. The LEADS programming staff periodically checks ALS entries. The LEADS auditors will contact the agency TAC to manually remove the expired entry if entered as a supplemental record.

As a reminder, to enter an ALS the following codes must be used: PUR/2 EXL/B CLA/AS OFF/5499OL AUTO SUSPENSION MIS/OVI-OL AUTO SUSPENSION

#### **PERSON FILE CHANGES**

The Missing Person File is being modified to require the date and time report taken (DRT) of the missing person report. The NCIC TOU 10-4 will also be implemented as well as the ETN (ethnicity) field in NCIC TOU 11-2. The 'SA' code utilized for activating the Endangered Missing Adult Alert will no longer read "Senior Alert" on the hit response. It has been modified to read "Endangered Missing Adult Alert". See example:

\*\*\*SENIOR ALERT\*\*\*ISSUED FOR NIC/M340031382\*\*\*SENIOR ALERT\*\*\*

has been replaced with:

\*\*\*ENDANGERED MISSING ADULT ALERT\*\*\*ISSUED FOR NIC/M123456789.

The cancellation message now reads:

\*\*\*ENDANGERED MISSING ADULT ALERT\*\*\*CANCELED FOR NIC/M123456789.

#### LEADS EXPIRATION REPORT

The TAC must ensure operators are taking the appropriate LEADS test. The TAC(s) must also ensure operators are removed from the list when they are no longer terminal users.

The auditors are finding operators with EXPIRED certification dates still listed on an agency's ACTIVE USERS list. The agency TAC must DISABLE all user accounts with EXPIRED certifications from the LEADS system if they will no longer be a certified operator. User accounts must also be DISABLED immediately upon termination of individual's employment.

Changes and modifications to the LEADS Expiration Report for agency operators must be completed using the LEADS OPERATOR UPDATE (LOU) Administrative Message form available in OpenFox<sup>™</sup> Messenger.

#### LEADS ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

LEADS Administrative Rule 13 has been rescinded. LEADS Administrative Rules are as follows: 4501:2-10-01 - 4501:2-10-12 and 4501:2-10-14



#### LEADS ADMINISTRATOR TRAINING

All new LEADS administrators are required to complete this online training located in the cjis launchpad/cjis training.

#### **IDENTITY THEFT VICTIMS**

Any driver license number starting with AR designates the license holder as a verified victim of identity theft.

#### LEADS SECURITY POLICY

The LEADS Security Policy has been revised (July 2013).

#### PERVISED RELEASE

The Deputy Suzanne Hopper Act (Senate Bill 7) effective September 4, 2013, requires the entry of Not Guilty by Reason of Insanity (NGRI), Incompetent to Stand Trial (IST), and Violent Persons on Supervised Release, to be entered into the NCIC Supervised Release File.

A form is being created for the courts and shall be used as the source document to assist agencies with the entry.

#### **MESSENGER 3.0 PATCH**

On July 10, 2013, LEADS released the next patch to *Messenger*. The release contained the highlighting of the background area to indicate where the cursor is currently prompted. This is a visual cue to quickly indicate where your focus is.

It also contained support for Java 7 for those of you installing computers with Windows 7 or Windows 8. The most notable change for the user is the encoding of the YQ/YR in the query responses. You will no longer have to right-click to see the option. The option will be seen in the response for you to click and submit.

Other minor changes are being made, and are more descriptive in the tips portion of *Messenger*. For those agencies on a 56k circuit/ slower connection, it would be advisable to download in the background.

#### Still using Microsoft?

On April 8, 2014, Microsoft will terminate support for the *Windows XP* Operating System (OS). *Windows XP* is one of the longest running/supported OS's for Microsoft. By the time support ends, XP will have been around for over 12 years. Since XP, Microsoft has released *Vista, Windows 7*, and *Windows 8* for desktops.

So what does this really mean to you?



Effective April 8, 2014, there will be no further security updates for the *Microsoft XP* OS. Any exploits (viruses, worms, trojans, etc.) found near or after April 8, 2014, will not be patched. The *Windows XP* OS will continue to run as normal, however, when Microsoft releases its patches on "Patch Tuesdays," after April 8, 2014, the *Microsoft XP* OS will no longer be included.

Since there will not be any further updates, *Windows XP* will become more vulnerable to exploits. New vulnerabilities will certainly be discovered that could impact *Windows XP* on a regular basis. Some of these vulnerabilities may be critical and could allow a hacker to take control or cripple a machine running *Windows XP*.

As such, on April 8, 2014, LEADS will no longer allow machines running *Windows XP* to connect to our network. Any machine found running *Windows XP* on or after April 8, 2014, will be denied access to the LEADS network.
