Hint: In text fields it is important to remember some search hints:

%smith: will find any name with smith at the end.

Results could be; Smith, Goldsmith, or Bernsmith

Smith%: would find any name starting with smith

Results could be; Smith, Smithman, or Smith-woosstein

%smith%: would find any name with smith contained in the name

Results could be; Smith, Woodsmith, Everysmithman
