AGENDA ITEMS

1. PULSE POINT APPLICATION

- a. Starting 60-trial

2. FIRE GROUND

- a. Repeated vs. non-repeated
 - i. Recommendation was made to continue operating on non-repeated talk groups

6. MABAS

- a. CAD demonstration on MABAS info programmed into CAD
- b. All agencies interested and will forward updated MABAS policies to DiCicco

7. RUN CARDS & UNIT RECOMMENDATIONS

- a. CAD demonstration on unit recommendations
- b. All agencies interested and will follow up with DiCicco for programming

8. EMERGENCY ALERTS

- a. New Emergency Alert will go out on a repeated FD-EMERG talk group.
- b. Only CVD will have the ability to hear the traffic
- c. Mic will be hot for 30-seconds
- d. Viewed as another way to get help if non-repeated talkgroup is not working
- e. Portable will HAVE to be reset (long press of emerg button) in order to resume original talkgroup.
- f. Each agency to defer to their department if they want this feature added.

9. RADIO PROGRAMMING

- a. Goal is to reprogram radios at the end of February
- b. Adding Solon, Beachwood and select Cleveland talk groups
- c. DiCicco to send out current template
- d. Each agency to agree on future template adjustments prior to programming

USPATCY.

10. RDP SERVER

- a. Server is operation
- b. DiCicco to reach out to Fritz and Vedder for training
- c. Vedder to conduct Q/A for EMD / 911 Calls

11. CAD INTERFACES

- a. Firehouse interface is available with our CAD
- b. Cost per agency is \$ 1,290.00 for the FireHouse part with \$ 150.00 per year in support
- c. CVD to cover cost of TAC Interface
- d. Any agency interested need to contact DiCicco for setup and configuration

12. VACANT HOUSES / MEDICAL INFO

- a. Vacant house and special medical history can be programmed into CAD so responding units can be notified.
- b. Each agency to supply CVD with info for entry

13. PRE-PLANS

- a. Pre-Plans can also be stored in CAD for responding units with MDT's
