

## O.I.B.R.S Submission

The O.I.B.R.S submission screen extracts data from typically the previous month of Incident reports and creates a submission file to be sent to the state of Ohio. The start date represents the first day of the month that you want to submit records for. The Output file name defaults to the agencies ORI plus the month and year of the submission. The Select Output allows the user to select the location where the output file will be created. Pressing the Run it outputs the data. This process may take several minutes.



The Ohio Validator button opens a link to the Ohio online O.I.B.R.S. validation system. Press the Browse button and locate the file that was created by the TAC OIBRS submission and then press Upload. The Ohio System will then check the submission file.



The Test One Report OCA# is utilized to help test a single report that fails validation. Enter the report number to output and press Run It. The system will output that one report only.

The system then displays the six data elements that make up a single records submission to O.I.B.R.S. The user can manually examine the data. Note that Ohio ORCs are presented without the decimal point.
